

**Conditions offered by the applicant.**

1. Alcohol supplied for consumption on the premises before 18:00 hours shall be ancillary to a table meal.
2. The premises will operate an age verification policy set at a minimum of 25 years, whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 25 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age.
3. The only form of ID that will be accepted are passports, driving licences with a photograph or Citizen card or validated proof of age cards bearing the "PASS" mark hologram. The list of approved ID may be amended or revised subject to prior written agreement with Metropolitan Police Service.
4. Signage advertising the "Challenge 25" policy will be displayed in prominent locations in the premises and shall include the point of sale and the area where the alcohol is displayed, as a minimum.
5. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Council or the Police, which will record the following:
  - (a) all crimes reported to the venue
  - (b) all ejections of patrons
  - (c) any complaints received concerning crime and disorder
  - (d) any incidents of disorder
  - (e) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
  - (f) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service

**Signage**

6. The premises shall prominently display signage informing customers: -
  - a. To leave quietly and to respect your neighbours.

**Dispersal Policy**

7. Dispersal Policy must be in place.

**Security**

8. A minimum of 2 SIA Staff will be employed by the premises after 2200 hours on Friday and Saturday. These staff must remain on site until 30 minutes after the terminal hour.
9. The premises will sign up to the Business Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP).
