

Conditions

Those on the current licence:

1. The premises licence holder is to install sensitive and highly modernised CCTV system with 24 hour surveillance, and should ensure premises not allowed for alcohol use at all.
2. The premises licence holder shall ensure that customers not allowed to get in if drunk.
3. The premises licence holder shall install 24 Hour CCTV system, surveillance, recording and keeping that record for public if needed.
4. The premises licence holder shall install an alarm system.
5. Only non-alcoholic drinks shall be served on the premises.
6. Halal food only service
7. The 24 hour police camera in front door of shop shall be maintained in working order.
8. Alcoholic drink shall be prohibited in this premises.
9. Drunk people shall not be allowed into this premises
10. All late night hours shall be take away only service
11. The premises licence holder shall have CCTV monitoring for public member coming in premises and keep in touch with police for data base information
12. Under 16 children served only when their parents are present on the premises.

Those proposed by Licensing in their representation to replace those offered by the applicant in their application (agreed by the applicant):

13. Notices shall be prominently displayed at the exit requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
14. All staff members should be checked to ensure they have the right to work in the UK. These checks should be made available upon requests to all responsible authorities.

Conditions 15 – 18 to replace current conditions 1, 3, 7 and 11 above.

15. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system including the police camera located at the front door of the premises. All entry and exit points must be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in a light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record for 24hours each and every day. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer of Lambeth Council.

16. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be in the premises at all times when the premises is open. This staff member must be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested and within a maximum of 24 hours of the initial request.
17. Subject to Data Protection guidance and legislation, the management of the premises will ensure that key staff are fully trained in the operation of the CCTV, and will be able to download selected footage onto a disk/USB Stick for the Police or authorised officers of the Local Authority without difficulty, delay or charge.
18. Any CCTV breakdown or system failure will be notified to the Police and Local Authority immediately & remedied as soon as practicable. Repair records / invoices shall be kept on site for at least 12 months and be readily available to be viewed by all authorised persons upon request.

Condition 19 to replace current conditions 2 and 9 above.

19. Anyone who appears to be drunk or intoxicated shall not be allowed entry to the premises and those who have gained entry will be escorted from the building immediately.

Condition 20 to replace current condition 8 above.

20. There shall be no alcoholic drinks allowed on the premises. Customers shall not be allowed to enter the premises with alcoholic drinking vessels or to consume alcohol on the premises.

Condition 21 to replace current condition 10 above.

21. From 23:00 customers shall be unable to dine in the premises and the activity of Late Night Refreshment shall be for take-away only. Tables and chairs within the premises will therefore be rendered unusable.

Condition 22 to replace current condition 12 above.

22. From 23:00 Children under the age of 18 shall not be allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a responsible adult.

Licensing have proposed that condition 5 above to be removed from the licence altogether as providing non-alcoholic drinks is not a licensable activity.

Those proposed by Public Protection which are different from those proposed in Licensing's representation (agreed by the applicant):

23. All staff members should be checked to ensure they have the right to work in the UK. These checks should be made available upon requests to all responsible authorities.
24. Install and maintain (and a terminal hour) a litter picking regime to the pavement directly outside of the premises to remove all discarded litter, drinking vessels, food waste/packageing, cigarette butts and the like.
