## **1. CONTEXT**

- 1.1 Lambeth Safeguarding Adults Board is the Safeguarding Adults Board for Lambeth for the purposes of s43 of the Care Act 2014.
- 1.2 S43 of the Care Act 2014 says the objective of a Safeguarding Adults Board is to help and protect adults in its area in cases where:
  - 1.2.1 An adult has care and support needs;
  - 1.2.2 They are experiencing or are at risk of abuse or neglect; and,
  - 1.2.3 They are unable to protect themselves from the abuse or neglect because of their care and support needs.
- 1.3 Schedule 2 of the Care Act 2014 requires a Safeguarding Adults Board to publish a report at the end of each financial year.
- 1.4 The work of Lambeth Safeguarding Adults Board proactively connects to the Future Lambeth: Our Borough Plan 2016-2021, which details:
  - “Safer and Stronger Communities” and 10-year outcome to “make the borough a safer place and keep people safe from harm”;
  - “prevention and early action” and work to change the way we support people, “building partnerships with families and voluntary and community groups”;
  - working together to reduce inequality and the 10-year outcome for “Integrated care which actively promotes recovery and independence, and which protects the vulnerable”
