Fu Manchu – Schedule of Conditions (replicated from previous lapsed licence)

GENERAL

The number of persons accommodated within the premises at any one time shall not exceed 200 persons. Or any other figure as identified by the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority or the council's health and safety officer.

The number of persons accommodated at any one time within the area, to which this licence relates, shall not exceed the 200 persons. (The accommodation figure is subject to 2 settee's and 2 armchairs being remove from the premises until these are removed the accommodation figure shall be restricted to 170 persons)

An approved sound limiting device shall be installed within the premises to control all power outlets all performers must plug into that system which shall be set at a cut out level determined by the Council and maintained at the set level by the licensee.

Noise from amplified music shall not increase the night time background noise level in any one third octave centre frequency band, when measured one metre in front of the nearest residential or noise sensitive premises in Lendal Terrace.

Signs shall be displayed within the premises requesting patrons to leave quietly and not linger outside the premises.

Noise from all plant, or equipment installed on the above premises, shall not increase the night time background noise level in any one third octave centre frequency band, when measured one metre in front of the nearest residential or noise sensitive premises in Lendal Terrace, Cadmus Close, Clapham High Street and Aristotle Road.

A scheme for soundproofing the premises shall be submitted to the Council's Noise and Pollution section for approval before the commencement of any work.

Consent is given for the premises to remain open for public entertainment as follows:-

- a) 11pm Sunday to Thursday until Midnight each day.
- b) 11pm Friday until 1am on the day following.
- c) 11pm Saturday until 2am on the day following.

The licensee shall only use door supervisors, registered by the Security Industry Agency, the licensee must keep a record of the name, address, badge number and the date the person was on duty at the premises. This record must be kept on the premises and be available for inspection by authorised officers of the council and police officers, at all times the premises is open to the public.

Should a future noise nuisance be confirmed to be emanating from the premises the licensee will be required to carry out the following sound insulation work:-

- a) Replace the existing front glazed façade with secondary glazing.
- b) Install a graphic equaliser to control low frequency music.

The shutter in front of the emergency exit on to Lendal Terrace must be locked in the open position at all time the premises is in use and open to the public.

The adjacent Arch 634 is not licenced for public entertainment, and must not be used for storage except within the designated storage area and must kept clear at all times.

2 PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

The premises licence holder or the designated premises supervisor shall ensure that the CCTV is maintained in working order, that recordings are retained for retained for an appropriate period of time.

3 PUBLIC SAFETY

Smoke, fire detectors and fire alarm system shall be installed within the premises, this shall be maintained in a working order at all times.

Registered door supervisors shall be provided to the licensed premises to prevent the admission and ensuring the departure from the premises of the drunk and disorderly without causing further disorder.

Registered door supervisors shall be provided to the licensed premises to prevent excluded individuals (subject to court bans or imposed by the license holder) from gaining access to the premises.

Registered door supervisors shall be provided to carry out searches on persons and to exclude those who may be carrying illegal drugs or offensive weapons.

Door supervisors shall be provided to the licensed premises to maintain orderly queuing outside of the premises.

Door supervisors working at licensed premises shall display their names badges on their outer most clothing, such that it is visible to the public and can be easily verified.

The premises licence holder or designated premises supervisor shall provide at least one female door supervisor - if female customers are to be subjected to body searches.

The premises licence holder or club official shall ensure that all emergency lighting batteries are fully charged before the admission of the public, members or guests into the premises and shall ensure that in the event of a failure of normal lighting, where the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of one hour, arrangements are in place to ensure that the public, members or guests leave the premises within 20 minutes unless within that time normal lighting has been restored and the batteries are being re-charged. If the emergency lighting battery has a capacity of 3 hours, the premises should be vacated within 1 hour.

The premises licence holder or persons acting on their authorisation shall ensure that curtains, hangings and temporary decorations are arranged so as not to obstruct exits, fire safety signs or fire-fighting equipment; and temporary decorations are not used without prior notification to the licensing authority/fire authority. The fire equipment shall be maintained in good working order.

The premises licence holder or designated premises supervisor shall maintain a record on the premises showing the number of door supervisors, where and what times they are stationed on the premises, the displaying of named badges and proof of registration.

4 PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

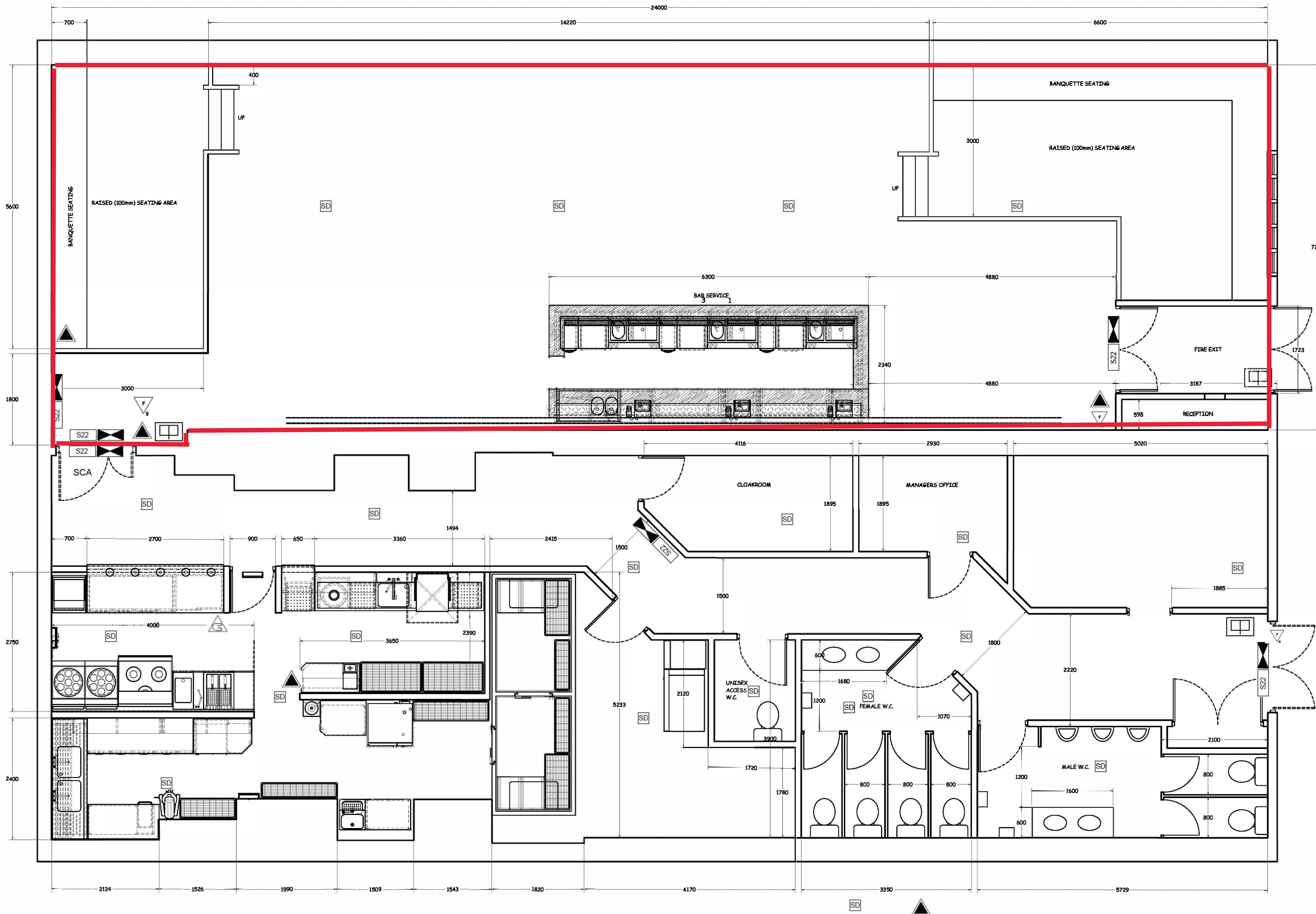
The premises licence holder or club official shall ensure that prominent, clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits requiring customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the area quietly.

The premises licence holder shall maintain the sound limiting device currently operational with the music system within the premises.

All fire exit doors must be available for use i.e. not locked, held open with any equipment or implement, obstructed, or impinged in any way throughout the time the premises are opened.







