

Agreed conditions for Lounge 41 Ltd, 25 Leigham Court Road, Streatham Hill London SW16 2ND

1. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be in the premises at all times when the premises is open. This staff member must be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested and within a maximum of 24 hours of the initial request.
2. Subject to Data Protection guidance and legislation, the management of the premises will ensure that key staff are fully trained in the operation of the CCTV, and will be able to download selected footage onto a disk/USB Stick for the Police or authorised officers of the Local Authority or UK Border Agency without difficulty, delay or charge.
3. Any CCTV breakdown or system failure will be notified to the Police and Local Authority immediately & remedied as soon as practicable. Repair records / invoices shall be kept on site for at least 12 months and be readily available to be viewed by all authorised persons upon request.
4. The supply of alcohol on the premises shall only be to persons seated taking a table meal there and for consumption by such persons as ancillary to their meal.
5. Notices shall be prominently displayed within the premises stating that CCTV is in operation.
6. The premises will be an active member of the licencing forum or similar group where there is one in operation.
7. All staff member should be checked to ensure they have the right to work in the UK. Records of these checks shall be maintained at the premises and shall be made available for inspection upon requests to all responsible authorities.
8. All staff members engaged, or to be engaged, in selling alcohol on the premises shall receive full training pertinent to the Licensing Act, specifically in regard to age-restricted sales, and the refusal of sales to persons believed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. This shall take place every 12 months.
9. All such training is to be fully documented and signed by not only the employee but the person delivering the training. Training records shall be kept at the premises and made available upon request to either Police Officers or an authorised officer of Lambeth Council.
10. Staff must ensure that all empty glasses and bottles are promptly cleared away from the public areas.
11. Patrons temporarily leaving the premises to smoke shall not be more than five at any time and not permitted to take any drinks with them.
12. Patrons shall be requested not to loiter outside the premises.
13. All alcoholic beverages must be secured behind the bar.
14. An incident log and refusals shall be kept at the premises and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Lambeth Council or the Police. It must be completed within 24 hours of the incident and will record the following:
 - a) all crimes reported to the venue
 - b) all ejections of patrons

- c) any complaints received concerning crime and disorder
 - d) any incidents of disorder
 - e) any faults in the CCTV system, searching equipment or scanning equipment.
 - f) any refusal of the sale of alcohol including date, time and name of staff member.
 - g) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
15. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
 16. A record shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The record shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer of Lambeth Council at all times whilst the premises is open
 17. The premises will operate an age verification policy set at a minimum of 25 years, whereby any person attempting to buy alcohol who appears to be under 25 will be asked for photographic ID to prove their age. Logs will be kept on site to record any rejections
 18. A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
 19. Signage advertising the aforementioned proof of age scheme shall be prominently displayed throughout the premises with a particular emphasis on the alcohol display area and service area.
 20. All tables and chairs to remain in-situ at all times whilst licensing activities are taking place.
 21. Any person entering the premises who appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall in the interests of other members of the public using the premises be requested to leave the premises.
 22. No deliveries to the premises shall take place between 22.00hrs and 08.00hrs on the following day.

All the above conditions are brought to your attention for consideration. Please note that if they are not agreed, a representation will be made against the application to impose the conditions.
