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Dear PC Watson

Thank you for your advice regarding our application.

I am currently working with Lambeth Events on the event management plan and risk assessment for the event, which is required for the use of the Vauxhall Pleasure Gardens and is to be provided as supporting documentation to the application. I had an extremely productive conversation with Claire Horan (copied in) yesterday and her guidance has and will be invaluable in making sure that we are prepared for the event.

The event management plan contains a noise management plan, crowd management, risk assessment and more detail on the service of alcohol, waste management etc.

It is my hope that once this plan is complete and forwarded to you and your colleagues your concerns will be addressed.

In the mean time, to answer some of your points. Alcohol will be served in plastic. In January 2020 the venue did not have cctv. It has since been installed as part of our reopening post lockdown. The hours on the application are in line with the existing premises licence for the venue. The live music will end at 9:30. The venue normally closes between 10 and 11 and while having the ability to serve until 00:00 makes sure we are within the law if some audience are still in the area at that time, the finish time of the music allows for a slow egress from the Gardens over a couple of hours.

I apologise that these documents are not being presented together with the application for the TEN. I thought it best to get the ball rolling on the TEN application so that everyone knew it was coming.

I have a telephone meeting booked with Claire on Wednesday to go over the plan and it is my hope that if Events are happy with it that it will also assuage your concerns.

This is a celebration of the fact that we have been serving the people of Vauxhall for ten years. Our intention is to entertain the people that love our venue and the community that has welcomed us and supported us over the years. We wish to provide some much needed joy and coming together after such a difficult year and a half of isolation.

I hope you might hold your objection until the event management plan can be presented. Of course I would also be delighted to work with you to mitigate any concerns you might have with anything in the documents and plans once you have been through them.
