### **3. HOMES FOR LAMBETH PROGRAMME PROGRESS REPORT**

Officers introduced the progress report, and it was highlighted that the report was the first use of this comprehensive format with this meeting.

Updates were given on the build programme, programme finance, housing management, resident engagement and health, equalities and vulnerability work.

There was particular discussion on how delivery of this programme is already achieving, and will further achieve, greater employment benefits for the residents of the borough.

The continued wholistic approach to Equalities Impact Assessments (EQIA) was welcomed by the panel. The panel asked

- to see the template for using the EQIA during delivery of the developments
- for the timing of the EQIA work during delivery to be clear
- for EQIA Panel reports to also be circulated to OSP members
- for further discussion on how intersectionality is considered as part of the EQIA process

There was discussion of the resident engagement figures. The panel asked for better context for the number of individual people engaged in addition to number of engagement activities. HFL advised that they will be using a new customer relationship management system from and this will enable greater level of detail.
