

## **Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule for COST CUTTER LOCAL**

1. All sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises shall be sealed containers only, and shall not be consumed on the premises.
2. The promise shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of the Lambeth Police Licensing Team. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition.
3. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises.
4. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of the police or an authorised officer throughout the preceding 31 day period.
5. A staff member staff from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open to the public. This staff member shall be able to show police recent data or footage with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
6. No super strength beer, lagers or ciders of 6.5% ABV (alcohol by volume) or above shall be sold at the premises except for premium beers and ciders sold in glass bottles.
7. No more than 20% of the sales area to be used at any one time for the sale, exposure for sale, or display of alcohol.
8. There shall be no self-service of spirits on the premises except for spirit mixtures below 5.5% ABV (alcohol by volume).
9. A challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
10. A diary log shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer of the Lambeth Council at all times whilst the premises are open.
11. The premise shall ensure that reasonable and adequate staff training shall be carried out and properly documented in relation to, dealing with incidents and prevention of crime and disorder: sale of alcohol (to underage, persons over 18 purchasing for underage, drunks etc.) prior to being allowed to sell alcohol.
