1	<p>Radbourne Road</p> <p>I have been passed your letter of 1st September to our resident at ■■■ Radbourne Road SW12 regarding Disabled Parking in the street.</p> <p>I am not sure if you are aware that we are a charitable housing organisation which has 150 properties in Radbourne Road and Telferscot Road and was founded 100 years ago to provide housing for infirm or disabled ex-armed forces personnel and their families. This is something that we continue to do today and is a service that the Foundation will be continuing to provide well into the future.</p> <p>This is the reason that there are more than the average number of Disabled Parking spaces in these roads, in order to accommodate the needs of our current residents and those who will replace them when vacancies occur.</p> <p>I hope that in light of this you will understand why we would not wish for the number of Disabled Parking spaces to be reduced in number and understand that they are important to assist our residents to live an independent life in their own homes. They also require access for ambulances, hospital transport for regular appointments and community transport vehicles. I understand that a number of our residents have received the same letter and obviously they are in the same position regarding parking and access.</p> <p>This matter was also raised with us back in 2018 and I responded then but did not receive a reply at that time,</p> <p>I would be grateful if you could confirm that the parking arrangements will remain as they are so that we can reassure our residents that they will not encounter problems in the future.</p> <p><u>Officer Response:</u> We will leave these bays in place to ensure a continuity of the facilities for The E Hayes Dashwood Foundation's residents.</p>
