Following a Closure Order received by the Licencing Authority on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2017 from Camberwell Magistrates Court. The order concerns matters, detailed below, heard between Superway Express (Mr Awan) and the Police before a District Judge on 24<sup>th</sup> February 2017.

Regulation 37 of the Licensing Act 2003 (Premises licences and club premises certificates) Regulations 2005 (SI 2005/42)states:

Review of premises licence following closure order

37 In the case of a review of a premises licence under section 167 (review of premises licence following a closure order), within the period of one working day starting on the day after the day on which the relevant licensing authority received the notice...from the magistrates' court, the relevant licensing authority shall give to the holder of the premises licence and each responsible authority notice in writing of—

- (a) the review;
- (b) the dates between which [responsible authorities and any other persons] may make representations relating to the review to the relevant licensing authority;
- (c) the closure order and any extension of it; and
- (d) any order made in relation to it under section 165(2).

Section 80(9) of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, provides that the, “...court must notify the relevant licensing authority if it makes a closure order in relation to premises in respect of which a premises licence is in force.”

Section 167(1) of the Licensing Act 2003 provides that where:

- (a) a magistrates' court has made a closure order under Section 80 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, or the Crown Court has made a closure order on appeal under section 84 of that Act, in relation to premises in respect of which a premises licence has effect, and
  - (b) the relevant licensing authority has accordingly received a notice under section 80(9)... of that Act,
- (2) The relevant licensing authority must review the premises licence.
  - (3) The authority must reach a determination on the review no later than 28 days after the day on which it receives the notice mentioned in subsection (1)(b).

It is therefore mandatory that a Premises Licence Review is required.
