LICENSING ACT 2003 – PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

On Friday the 7th of July council officers and police visited your premises during a joint enforcement visit to premises within the Brixton market area.

We approached your premises as we noticed that live music was being provided immediately outside the premises and your premises, we asked why you were playing live music outside your premises and one of your staff said it was band practice, and we asked that they can continue the practice indoors as this was beginning to attract stragglers, who otherwise would have left the area.

I am pleased to note on record that your premises complied with the request and no further music was played outside.

Please note that it is essential to operate your premises in such a way that it does not engage with any of the four licensing objective.
