Consultation Plan

1. This consultation plan sets out the consultation that will be carried out on the Preliminary Draft Charging Schedule (PDCS) which proposes new CIL rates in Lambeth. This will be held simultaneously with the public consultation on a partial review of the Local Plan and on the Transport Strategy as well. The plan is consistent with the policies set out by Lambeth's Statement of Community Involvement adopted in September 2015.
2. The public consultation on the PDCS, the Local Plan and the Transport Strategy will be held from 22 October to 17 December 2018 for a total of eight weeks. The PDCS and supporting documents including the Viability Study and the Infrastructure Delivery Plan will be made available during the first day of public consultation.
3. The consultation methods will be as follows:
 - The PDCS and supporting documents including the Viability Study and the Infrastructure Delivery Plan will be published on the Lambeth website and in social media
 - Emails will be sent to all statutory and non-statutory consultees setting out the PDCS and supporting documents
 - If necessary, where email is unavailable, letters will be sent out to statutory and non-statutory consultees setting out the PDCS and supporting documents
 - A copy of the PDCS and supporting documents will be made available for inspection at the Council's offices in the Civic Centre and in all of the libraries in Lambeth
 - Two workshops on CIL will be held – one for locally based community groups and another for developers.
4. Everyone is welcome to comment on the PDCS and supporting documents. Please contact the Lambeth CIL Team if you would like to know more about CIL or to find out more about our consultation.
5. All consultation responses must be received by 5pm on the last day of public consultation. Comments received after this date will not be taken into consideration.
